This year was full of fun, laughs, and the word "slay" with Faith and I am excited to support her through her next journey!

As I end my 6th year in this organization, I often get asked why I continue to compete in the Miss America Opportunity. My reasons are compiled into a lengthy list including the scholarship dollars to further my education in becoming a dentist, the endless friendships, interview skills, and the ability to network. Through networking and connections that I made as Miss Southeastern Massachusetts, I was able to earn 2 dental assisting jobs within the dental field. My year was nothing short of spectacular and as I reflect on my growth throughout my year as Miss Southeastern Massachusetts, I see the determined, ambitious, motivated, outgoing, and welcoming person that thrived and will continue to thrive throughout my next journey. 
