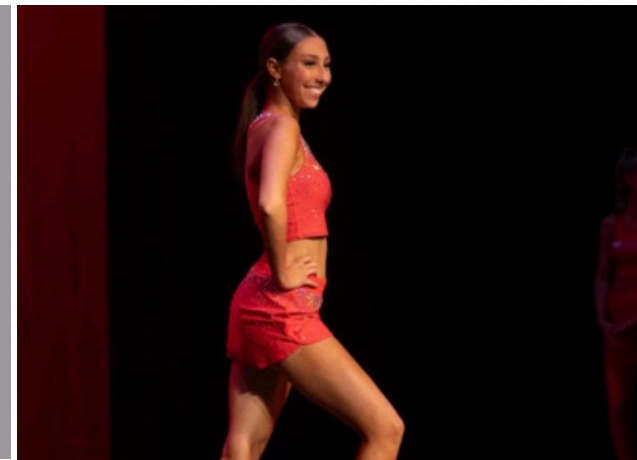

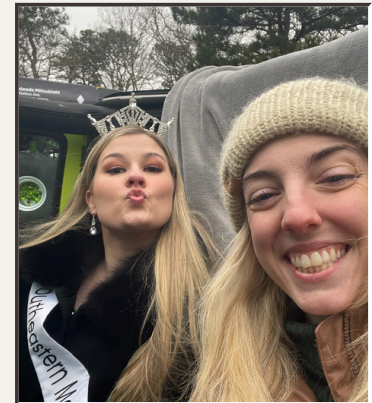

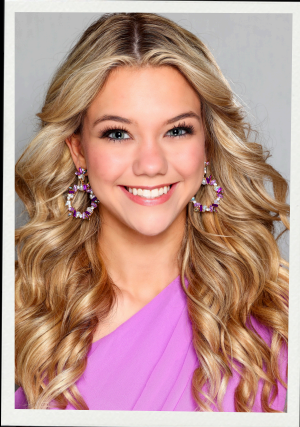
JUDGES CHAIRPERSON
